- Fr. Robert: Indonesian way of welcoming us us inculturation

- In Philippines we follow the Totus Tuus journey prepared by Fr. Maria. It is the preparation of 33 days. It is divided with four different weeks with four different themes dealt. At the end we have the consecration together. The liturgy is also included with different readings. The last week is very intensive that of the Knowledge of Jesus Christ. This method is suggested by Fr. De. Montfort
