INTRODUCTION

Opening Words

«The Continental Year for Africa and Madagascar is still not over.... Still keeping to heart the warmth of this Continental Year of Africa and Madagascar, now the entire Congregation is asked to turn its attention to the Montfortian entities that exist in Asia and Oceania. On these two giant continents, the little Company of Mary has four entities: India, Indonesia, PNG and the Philippines».

«Common points that exist in the context of Asia and Oceania, in particular the context of the countries in which we are working today. These points can be found in the answers of the Superiors of the Entities. We then summarized them in the following ideas.

a. Rich in diversity: religion, culture, values, ethnicity, language....

- b. In the field of religion in particular: the flourishing of spirituality and religiosity. So, there is a need to build dialogue among Religions and Churches.
- c. We need to live inculturation.
- d. Asian and Oceanic people show hospitality.
- e. The Church is marked by a zeal for missionary work and a lively devotional life, especially to Our Lady. There are also indications of clericalism in the Church.
- f. The enormous uncertainty of the political and economic system. Especially in the economic sector, there appears to be poverty here and there. JPIC needs to do something in this area».

«How to become Montfort Missionaries or Montfortian Associates in this context. We find that the answers of the Superiors of Entities sound the same because they all emphasize the importance of having a clear «Montfortian identity» in which there is evangelization, a vital relationship with Mary (through devotion to Mary, especially with the practice of Consecration to Jesus through Mary), the role of the laity also in relation to leadership».

The theme chosen by the confreres in Asia and Oceania for their year of continental mission in 2022 is: «Rise and Shine, Montfort in Asia-Oceania».

MONTFORTIAN ENTITIES IN ASIA AND OCEANIA

Mission in India:

The Montfort Missionaries have been present in the country since 1971. Today the Vice-Province of India has 65 priests, 2 bishops, 35 scholastics, 4 novices, 4 pre-novices and 60 members of the Montfortian Associates.

«In India, confreres on perpetual vows can be found in the Vice-Provincial administrative house, in houses for initial formation (minor seminary, pre-novitiate, novitiate, scholasticate), in a social home for underprivileged children, in two schools and on coffee plantations; the rest work in parishes. Still in India, there is a Marian Center, which also works in conjunction with sharing the Montfortian spirituality with Montfortian Associates. In addition, there are also confreres who are involved in itinerant preaching and become spiritual animators for various ecclesiastical groups».

Mission in Indonesia:

The Montfort Missionaries have been present in the country since 1939. Today, the Province of Indonesia has 71 priests, 1 Brother in perpetual vows, 2 scholastics in perpetual vows, 66 scholastics in temporary vows, 4 Brothers in temporary vows, 15 novices, 16 postulants and 335 members of the Montfortian Associates.

«In Indonesia, the confreres serve in the administrative field of the Province, apart from letting themselves available as spiritual guides for various ecclesiastical groups. There are many confreres who work in the field of formation (two minor seminaries belonging to the dioceses, community of aspirants, postulant-novitiate, scholasticate) and in parishes. They can also be found in the two categorical missionary communities «à la Montfort». This entity pays attention to sharing spirituality through Montfortian Associates locally called «*Kerabat Santo Montfort*» (KSM)».

Mission in Papua New Guinea:

The Montfort Missionaries are present in this country since 1958. Today, this General Delegation has 12 priests, 1 bishop, 1 Brother in perpetual vows. To be precise, they are missionaries who come from various entities: there are 5 confreres from India, there are 7 confreres from Indonesia, there is 1 missionary from the Philippines and 1 missionary from Madagascar. Today, this General Delegation has 5 postulants; 3 scholastics of temporary vows of which 2 are sent from the General Delegation of Francophone Africa. This entity has 32 members of the Montfortian Associates.

«In PNG, almost all the confreres can be found in parishes, even the Superior of the entity administration of the PNG Delegation General is still a parish priest. This is important for their financial autonomy. Now they also have a formation house located in the country's capital, Port Moresby. This entity has just started to open itself up to share the Montfortian spirituality with the laity».

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Mission in the Philippines:

The decision to start the Montfortian mission in the Philippines was taken in 1983. Today, this General Delegation has 18 priests, 1 Brother in perpetual vows, 2 scholastics in perpetual vows and 5 scholastics in temporary vows. The Philippines has 99 members of the Montfortian Associates without counting the many who have consecrated themselves to Jesus through Mary according to the teachings of Saint Louis-Marie de Montfort.

«In the Philippines, the spread of the Montfortian spirituality is very prominent in the work of the confreres. There were certain confreres who were assigned to it, but all the confreres who serve in other fields are actually involved. They all work together in a solid team of very dedicated lay people. Apart from this special area, confreres are found in houses of formation, in parishes and in the administration of the General Delegation of the Philippines».

«It should be specifically mentioned here that in India, Indonesia and the Philippines there are some Missionaries who continue their missionary work by carrying the cross of their health. Sick confreres continue to receive the attention of the responsible of these entities in order to find the best solutions for the restoration of their health. It is certain that their missionary life emanates from prayers offered in struggling silence, from willingness to be cared for, from smiles and patience».
