

April 28, 2021: Celebration of the Feast of Saint Louis-Marie de Montfort in Madagascar

ANTANANARIVO, Madagascar - "How beautiful it is to see running over the mountains the messenger who announces peace, the messenger of the good news who announces salvation, the one who comes to speak to the holy city; "He is king, your God"." (Is 52,7)

It is also beautiful to see tireless apostles ablaze with the ardent desire to preach the Good News all over the world, in fraternal service following a Saint, "apostolic missionary", named Louis-Marie de Montfort. Let us note that, in our entity, we are also celebrating on this date the 19th year of priesthood of Fathers Bruno, Seraphim, Liva, Alexandre, André and the 5th year of priesthood of Fathers Philibert, Clément and Cyrille.
