**TAGAYTAY CITY, Philippines** - The Delegation of the Montfort Missionaries in the Philippines had their Annual Retreat from November 18 to 22, 2019 at the Bethlehem House of Prayer of the Franciscan Missionaries of the Infant Jesus in Tagaytay. The theme of this year's retreat is "*Mystery of Incarnation: The Ground of Our Being and Ministry as Montfortians"*.
