

Renewal of Consecration in Malawi

NANTIPWIRI, Malawi - Christmas celebration for 2024 had double blessings for the lay Associates in Byumbwe Parish, Blantyre archdiocese. They renewed their consecration to Jesus through the Blessed Virgin Mary on 26th December 2024, a day after Christmas. The renewal of the Consecration started with a two-hour recollection facilitated by Fr. Petro CHILUMPHA, SMM the parish priest of Ugandan martyrs known as Byumbwe parish.

During the recollection Fr. Petro, emphasized that consecration is based on the sacrament of baptism and every individual who wants to concentrate themselves to Jesus through Mary must first be willing, totally submitted to Jesus, joyful consecrate themselves and accept God's gift, Jesus through Mary.
